Please keep your child's health forms current at KOCO. This includes physicals, immunizations, and medication administration permissions.

Expired health forms put KOCO out of compliance with the State of CT. I try to reach out to families well before updated forms are due. These emails require a response — whether it's the updated form, an appointment date, or an explanation of why the updated form might be delayed.

Providing current health forms is just as important an obligation as paying tuition. Especially now, with some doctor's offices taking weeks to provide appointments or send completed health forms, it's critical that families be proactive.
